European Population Conference 2008 Migration and Migrants in Europe Barcelona 9-12th July

The European Association for Population Studies invites you to participate in the upcoming European Population Conference, which will be held in Barcelona from 9 to 12 July 2008. The EPC 2008 is a general scientific conference where Migration and Migrants in Europe will receive special attention in the plenary session. International migration has become the most important factor in population growth in Europe and migration issues are central to population studies.

Simultaneous sessions are the core of the conference program. The deadline for submissions of Abstracts is October 15th 2007. Applicants must submit their abstracts on-line at the Conference website <http://epc2008.princeton.edu/>. Submissions should be channeled to one of the conference topics listed below. Each topic will be developed into a series of sessions by the Convener. Applicants will be informed whether their paper is accepted for presentation in a regular or poster session by December 2007.
